- Objectives : To learn the basic 46 sentence structures at the beginning level and to develop basic skills in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. To study 60 kanji required for Level N5 of JLPT. To be able to use Japanese in conversational situations.
- Prerequisite : Completion of about 40 hours of studying Japanese, Beginning 1 course, or JLPT N-5 level. Command of hiragana and katakana.
- Textbook : Daichi Main Text (3A Network), Daichi Translation of the Main Text and Grammar Notes (3A Network)
- Evaluation : Final exam 30%, Vocabulary Quizzes 20%, Kanji Quizzes 10%, Grammar Quizzes 15%, Homework Assignments 20%, Classroom Activities 5%.

Course will be completed if all the following requirements have been met;

- 1) Have attended more than 70% of classes
- 2) Have completed final exam and/or final assignment

Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows:

A:80-100% B:65-79% C:50-64% F:0-49%

Makeup exams for final exams can be scheduled ONLY in the one week period after the exam date. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeups will be offered for other quizzes.
