Objectives	: This course aims at developing an intermediate level of Japanese conversation skills (listening and speaking) on various situations that learners might encounter on campus and daily life. Taking this course, students will be able to carry out the conversation in more natural way, through mainly role play activities.
Prerequisite	: Completion of Intermediate1 Speaking course or JLPT N3 equivalent, CEFR B1 equivalent

Evaluation	: Classroom Evaluation 15%, Midterm Exam 30%, Final Exam 30%, Assignments 15%, Speech Presentation 5%, Participation 5%. • Course will be completed if all the following requirements have been met; 1) Have attended more than 70% of classes 2) Have completed final exam. • Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows: A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0% • Makeup exams for mid-term and final exams can be scheduled ONLY in the one week period after the exam date. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeups will be offered for other quizzes.
