- Prerequisite** : Completion of Beginning 1 course, or CEFR A1.1 equivalent. In addition, command of Hiragana and Katakana.

*We recommend buying the paper version textbook (printed textbook) for its ease of use and learning efficiency.
- Evaluation** : Classroom Activity 5%, Vocabulary Quiz 5%, Kanji Quiz 5%, Listening Quiz 5%, Writing Assignments 10%, Grammar Quiz 15%, Midterm Presentation 5%, Midterm Exam 20%, Final Presentation 10%, Final Exam 20%
- Course completion requires fulfillment of all the following conditions:
1) Attendance of more than 70% of scheduled classes; 2) Completion of the final exam; 3) A final grade higher than a C.
 - Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows:
A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0%
 - Makeup for the midterm and final exams can be scheduled only **WITHIN ONE WEEK** after regular exams. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeup will be offered for other quizzes.
