Objectives	: The course aims at developing Japanese language proficiency needed for dealing appropriately with various situations in campus and daily life. Through the activities focusing on abstract topics, students will develop overall listening, speaking, reading and writing skills and ability to understand the contents and express their own idea correctly by learning upper-intermediate sentence patterns and vocabulary.
Prerequisite	: Completion of Intermediate Integral 2 course or JLPT N2 equivalent, CEFR B2 equivalent

Evaluation	: Classroom activity 5%, Mid-term Exam 20%, Final Exam 20%, End-of-lesson assignments and self-study assignments 20%, Vocabulary assignments 10%, Writing assignment 10%, short speech 2%, Final presentation 13%. • Course completion requires fulfillment of all the following conditions: 1) Attendance of more than 70% of scheduled classes; 2) Completion of the final exam; 3) A final grade higher than a C. • Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows: A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0% • Makeup exams for mid-term and final exams can be scheduled ONLY in the one week period after the exam date. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeups will be offered for other quizzes.
