- Objectives** : To learn the basics of Japanese writing style, including the organization of paragraphs, expressions, and grammar. To practice writing a short composition in each class. To write two longer compositions as course assignments.
- Prerequisite** : Completion of Intermediate1 Writing course or JLPT N3 equivalent, CEFR B1 equivalent.
- Textbook** : Shoronbun e no 12 no Suteppu, Short Essays in 12 Steps
- Evaluation** : Class activities 10% Mid-term Exams 20% Final Exam 20% Assignments 35% Quizzes 15%
- Course completion requires fulfillment of all the following conditions:
 - 1) Attendance of more than 70% of scheduled classes; 2) Completion of the final exam; 3) A final grade higher than a C.
 - Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows:
A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0%
 - Makeup exams for midterm and final exams can be scheduled **ONLY** within one week after regular exams. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeup will be offered for other quizzes.
