 ・ Course completion requires fulfillment of all the following conditions:
 1) Attendance of more than 70% of scheduled classes; 2) Completion of the final exam; 3) A final grade higher than a C.
 ・ Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows:
 A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0%
 ・ Makeup exams for midterm and final exams can be scheduled ONLY within one week after regular exams. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeup will be offered for other quizzes.
