- Prerequisite : Completion of Beginning 3 or JLPT N5 equivalent, CEFR A2.1 equivalent

- Evaluation : Classroom Activity 5%, Midterm Exam 20%, Final Exam 20%, Final Presentation 10%, Vocabulary Quiz 5%, Kanji Quiz 5%, Grammar Quiz 12%, Writing Assignments 13%, Listening Assignments 10%
- Course completion requires fulfillment of all the following conditions:
1) Attendance of more than 70% of scheduled classes 2) Completion of the final exam 3) A final grade higher than a C.
 - Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows:
A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0%
 - Makeup exams for mid-term and final exams can be scheduled ONLY in the one week period after the exam date. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeups will be offered for other quizzes.
