- Objectives : This course aims to develop proficiency in Japanese language for dealing with situations in daily life. Through activities focusing on familiar topics, students will acquire a balance of listening, speaking, reading and writing skills by learning pre-intermediate sentence patterns and vocabulary.
- Prerequisite : Completion of Beginning 4 course, Intensive Beginning course or JLPT N4 equivalent, CEFR A2.2 equivalent.
- Textbook : Chuu-kyuu e ikoo Nihongo no bunkei to hyougen 55 Second edition (3A NETWORK)
- Evaluation : Class Activities 10%, Comprehension Quizzes 6%, Vocabulary Quizzes 7%, Kanji and Words Practices 7%, Compositions 10%, Midterm Exam 20%, Final Exam 20%, Final Presentation 20%
- Course completion requires fulfillment of all the following conditions:
    - 1) Attendance of more than 70% of scheduled classes; 2) Completion of the final exam; 3) A final grade higher than a C.
  - Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows:  
A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0%
  - Makeup exams for mid-term and final exams can be scheduled ONLY within one week after the regular exam. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeup will be offered for other quizzes.
