Through the activities focusing on general topics, students will develop overall listening, speaking, reading and writing skills by learning intermediate sentence patterns and vocabulary.
Prerequisite	: Completion of Intermediate Integral course or JLPT N3 equivalent, CEFR B1 equivalent

Evaluation	: Vocabulary Quizzes 10%, Compositions and Presentation 30%, Listening Quizzes 5%, Kanji Quizzes 5%, Midterm Exam 20%, Final Exam 20%, Classroom Activities 10%. • Course completion requires fulfillment of all the following conditions: 1) Attendance of more than 70% of scheduled classes; 2) Completion of the final exam; 3) A final grade higher than a C. • Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows: A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0% • Makeup exams for mid-term and final exams can be scheduled ONLY in the one week period after the exam date. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeups will be offered for other quizzes.
