- Objectives : This course aims at developing an intermediate level of listening Japanese ability through listening activities on various topics that learners might encounter on campus and daily life. Taking this course, students will be able to understand and summarize lectures, and presentations, and also news for everyday life.
- Prerequisite : Completion of Intermediate Listening course or JLPT N3 equivalent,CEFR B1 equivalent.
- Textbook : Ryuugakusei no tameno Academic Japanese Chookai [Chuukyuu] (3A Network)
- Evaluation : Classroom Activities 20%, Quizzes 10%, Assignments 30%, Midterm Exam 20% Final Exam 20%
- Course completion requires fulfillment of all the following conditions:
 - 1) Attendance of more than 70% of scheduled classes; 2) Completion of the final exam. 3) A final grade higher than a C.
 - Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows:
A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0%
 - Makeup exams for midterm and final exams can be scheduled ONLY within one week after regular exams. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeup will be offered for other quizzes.
- Notes : 1. Credits: *To receive credits, you must register with both STAR and UTAS yourself. UTAS code:Graduate 3799-932-1, Undergraduate FEN-JL4p10L1.
2. Students who do not need credits may also take this course. *You must register on STAR to take the course.
3. A course completion certificate will be given upon request to students who receive a letter grade of C or higher.

5. Missing more than 30 minutes of each class is considered an absence. Arriving at class late or leaving class early three times will be regarded as one absence.
6. The attendance of the first week will not be counted since it is an orientation week.
