- Prerequisite : Completion of Intermediate1 Reading/writing course or JLPT N3 equivalent, CEFR B1 equivalent

- Evaluation : Classroom Activities:10%,Vocab.Quizzes:10% Assignments:30%, Midterm Exam:25%, Final Exam:25%.  
 • Course will be completed if all the following requirements have been met; 1) Have attended more than 70% of classes 2) Have completed final exam 3) A final grade higher than a C.  
 • Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows: A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0%  
 • Makeup exams for mid-term and final exams can be scheduled ONLY in the one week period after the exam date. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeups will be offered for other quizzes.
