- Objectives : The course aims to develop advanced-level oral communication skills through a variety of activities, including conversation practice, discussions, speeches, and presentations on various social issues.
- Prerequisite : Completion of Intermediate Speaking course, or JLPT N1 equivalent, CEFR B2+ equivalent
- Textbook : Nihongo Choogyuu Washa e no Kakehashi Kichinto tsutaeru gijitsu to hyoogen (3A Network)
- Evaluation : Class Activities 10%, Mid-term Exam 25%, Final Presentation 25%, Vocabulary Quizzes 20%, Assignments 10%, Short speech 10%
- Course will be completed if all the following requirements have been met; 1) Have attended more than 70% of classes 2) Have completed final exam ; 3) A final grade higher than a C.
 - Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows: A:80-100% B:65-79% C:50-64% F:0-49%
 - Makeup exams for mid-term and final exams can be scheduled ONLY in the one week period after the exam date. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeups will be offered for other quizzes.
