Furthermore, it focuses on developing oral expression skills through activities such as discussions and presentations related to each theme.
- Prerequisite : Completion of Advanced 1 Listening course, Advanced 1 Speaking course, or higher proficiency than JLPT N1, CEFR C1 equivalent

- Evaluation : Classroom activity 20%, Presentation/short speech 25%, Assignments 15%, Mid-term Exam 20%, Final Exam 20% · Course will be completed if all the following requirements have been met; 1) Have attended more than 70% of classes 2) Have completed final exam 3) A final grade higher than a C. · Letter grades for the entire course will be assigned as follows: A:100-80% B:79-65% C:64-50% F:49-0% · Makeup exams for mid-term and final exams can be scheduled ONLY in the one week period after the exam date. Makeup exams will only be worth 80% of the possible score that can be attained through regular exams. No makeups will be offered for other quizzes.
